Location: Chapel

At least 3 priests to be present to hear confessions.

Service Project

Location: Gym

Start off with video, then begin with the hygiene kits from the IOCC. The goal of each group would be to complete 50-70 kits in that 45-minute period. The total goal is at least 500 kits.

O.L. Discussion

Location: Mansion

"How do we become peacemakers?"

Tying in the Orthodox understanding of Peace. The goal would be for each scout to leave with goals on how to be messengers of peace in their everyday lives

Free time

Location: Field

- 1. Each session will last 45 minutes.
- 2. Each group would be broken up into roughly 20 Scouts. Grades K-3 / 4,5 &6 / 7,8,9 / 10,11,12
- 3. At least two adults (either seminarian or troop leader), will always accompany each group, taking them from each rotation.
- 4. Remaining Seminarians will be either doing the O.L. Session, or the Service Project Session.



This year we have decided to work on the "Messengers of Peace" Award with our scouts.

One of the requirements is to work on a service project. We decided to work with the IOCC (International Orthodox Christian Charities) to provide 500 Hygiene Kits to people in need. For more information:

- 1. Cost of Retreat is **\$25 per person**, Scout, or Adult. Same price one day or for the weekend. This covers food [Saturday dinner and Sunday brunch] patches, and EOCS expenses.

- 4. Please show respect to our Seminarians. This is their retreat as well as ours!
- 5. **NO SMOKING** is permitted in front of the Scouts during the weekend. This should already be the policy of your unit during your normal meetings and outings.
- 6. **ALL!** Should attend all services: opening, confession, Vespers, and Sunday morning Liturgy. Scout leaders & volunteers should set good examples for their Scouts.
- 7. Full uniform is required at all times! (CLASS A)
- Please provide the EOCS chairman with names, of those present, of the ALPHA OMEGA, Chi Rho or St. George
 recipients for the past year during registration, only those present. These Scouts will be recognized at closing
 ceremonies.

- 9. Unit leaders must make sure that all Scouts always behave as Scouts. We are guests of St. Basil's, and everyone should behave properly.
- 10. Enclosed is a Permission Slip/Medical Release Form; please make copies one for each Scout attending. This is a national requirement from both Boy Scouts & Girl Scouts, as well as the EOCS. One properly filled in and signed form per Scout.
- 11. **ALL** adults are expected to assist in various functions when called upon. Unit Leaders should inform all their adults attending.
- 12. **All** Scouts must **bring bag lunches to the opening ceremony** and eat lunch with their group. Prepare properly for communion and confession.
- 13. The water faucet to fill up fire buckets is located outside of the GYM along the back of the building.
- Portable toilets will be available at the beginning of the trail. The GYM bathrooms will also be available but MUST BE IN PRISTINE CONDITIONS. Each Troop will be responsible for inspecting and maintaining the bathrooms throughout the event.
- The main building is off limits. Stay OUT!
